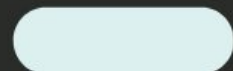
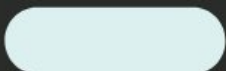

Each year they have guests tied to the GI Joe, A Real American Hero brand, whether they be voice actors from the iconic '80s cartoon, writers and artists of comics and or cartoon episodes or former Hasbro employees who were integral to the design and production of the GI Joe figures. Obviously the big draw of the show is the various GI Joe action figure vendors who bring out a ton of current and even better vintage toys.
